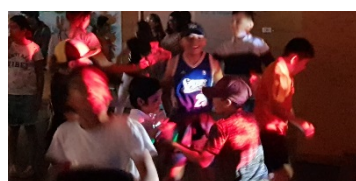

### Pop Up excursion

On Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> December, the school is hosting a student excursion from the bus location to our temporary pop-up school at Peakhurst West Public School. This will provide students a simulation of transport procedures and expectations as of next year.

Students in class/grade/stage groups will be shuttled between the Penshurst Public School bus location to Peakhurst West PS and back. Each class/grade/stage will spend approximately 50 minutes at Peakhurst West to familiarize themselves with the school playground, library, facilities and pop-up school as well as the bus pick up and drop off points.
