Last year, our Year 6 students completed the SEAT project. As part of this project, money was raised and donations were collected for students and schools in the Solomon Islands.

This week a shipping container filled with socks, shoes, underpants, sport uniforms, books and book shelving (donated by the students of three Sydney schools) arrived in the Solomon Islands. The 40 foot container, costs of shipping and an abundance of tools packed inside was generously donated by the Lions Club of Parramatta and their community partners. For those items that couldn't be transported, such as glass for the windows in Gilbert Camp school, solar panels and malaria tablets, money has already been transferred for these items to be purchased at the other side of this journey!
