The GRC Penshurst Campus Primary Links Program is a key part of our Transition Education Program. The main aim of the Primary Links Program is to provide Year 6 students with an experience of High School life to make their transition from primary school to Year 7 as comfortable, welcoming and engaging as possible.

From 2025, Georges River College Penshurst Campus will become co-educational. As a result, our Primary Links Program will be co-educational in 2024.

Your child’s primary school has been invited to be involved in this program.

Our 2024 Primary Links Program will have a major focus on Technology, Art, Science, English & Mathematics. The program will run on Tuesdays and will require students to attend GRC Penshurst Campus on a weekly basis (from 8:35am – 2:58pm) for 8 consecutive weeks. The eight-week program will provide a consistent experience for the students involved through a structured student timetable with specialist teachers.

At the conclusion of the 8-week course a Certificate of Participation will be presented to each student. This is to acknowledge student achievement and their involvement in the Primary Links Program.

Students participating in the program are required to arrange their own transport to and from our school.
